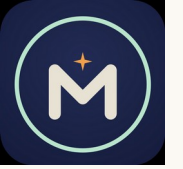


Places in our community

You may point, speak, draw or write.

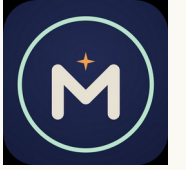


Start with what you know

LABEL

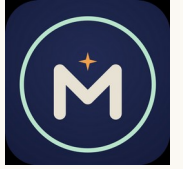
the name of a place.

a view from above.

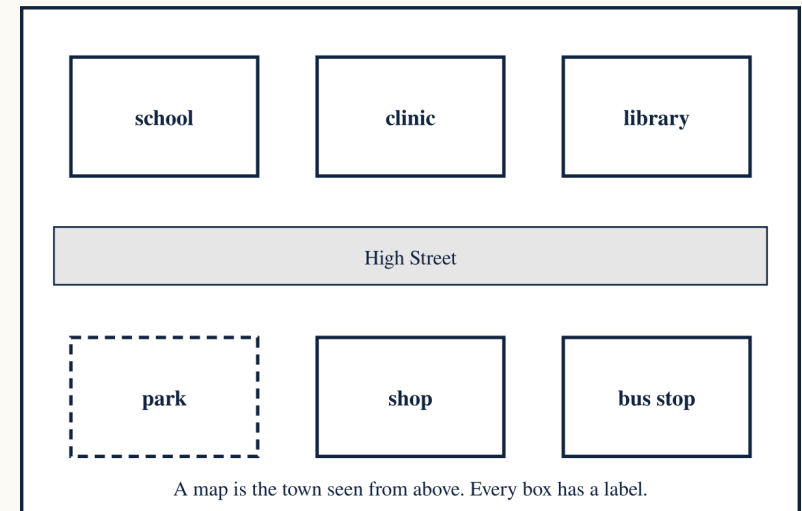
Helper: a person who helps.

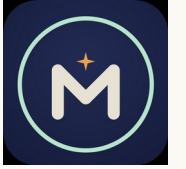


Read a town from above

Watch a worked example

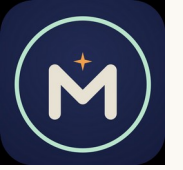
NOTICE

Library: borrow books; a librarian can help.

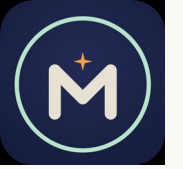


Try one together

What is a clinic for? Name one helper.



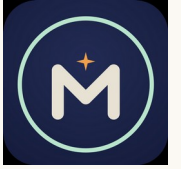
Choose, then explain

Choose A or B. Explain your choice.



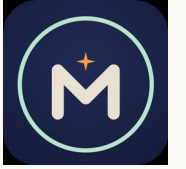

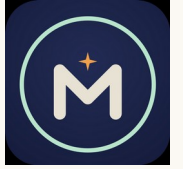
Show what you mean

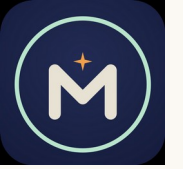
Check the reasoning

Health appointments / space to play.



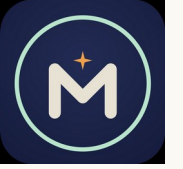
Your voice shapes the next step
