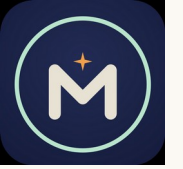


# Then and now

**You may point, speak, draw or write.**

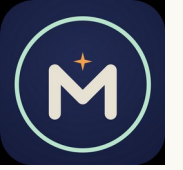


# Start with what you know

# Words that help

## EARLIER

---

before another time.

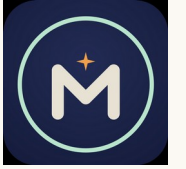
Later: after another time.

## EVIDENCE

---

a clue we can check.

Continuity: something stays.

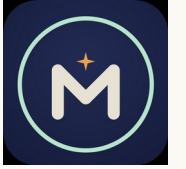


# A local place, two dates

appears in both photographs.**

Use the printed dates before guessing from colour.





# Watch a worked example

## NOTICE

---

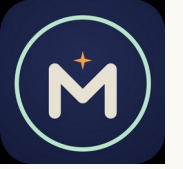
2008 comes before 2017.

Both photographs show the same bridge.

## EXPLAIN

---

A different camera view does not prove a change.

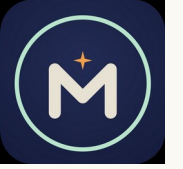


# Try one together

**Which is earlier? What can you see in both?**



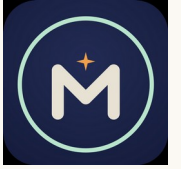
# Choose, then explain

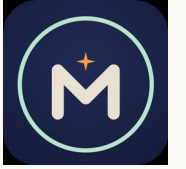

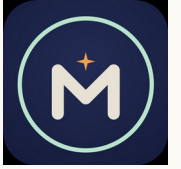

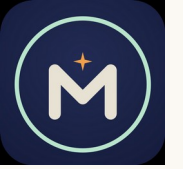

The library stays; the play area is added.



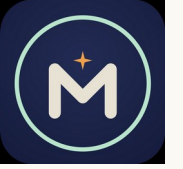
