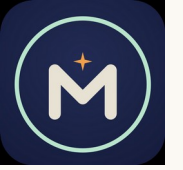


A timeline with a reason

Use a detail. Explain what it supports.

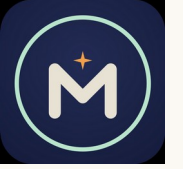


Start with what you know

Words that help

CHRONOLOGY

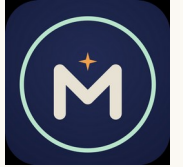
order by date.

Scale: equal years, equal gaps.

CRITERION

a judgement rule.

Significance: importance for a question.

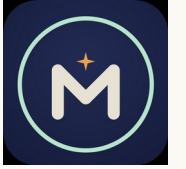


A date fixes a position

W records the 1948 Windrush arrival.

Its date stays the same whatever question we ask.

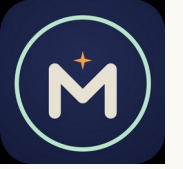
Watch a worked example

A question and evidence shape the ranking.

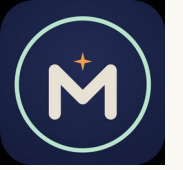


Try one together

How big is the gap from 1948 to 1963?

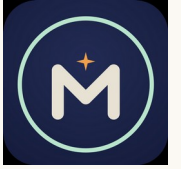


Choose, then explain

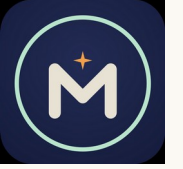
YOUR TASK

Re-rank for migration and explain the change.



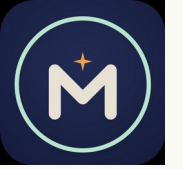
Make the reasoning visible

Keep your first answer for the check.



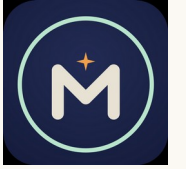
Check the reasoning

1963:63; 1965:65; 1973:73 mm.



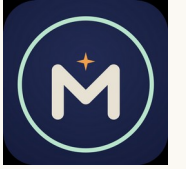
Your voice shapes the next step
