Card	Year	Event
T1	1918	Many women aged 30 and over who met property conditions gained a parliamentary vote; most men 21 and over could vote.
T2	1928	Women gained the parliamentary vote on the same age terms as men: 21.
T3	1948	Empire Windrush arrived at Tilbury on 22 June.
T4	1963	The Bristol bus-crew employment colour bar ended after the boycott campaign.
T5	1965	A Race Relations Act prohibited discrimination in specified public places, with important gaps.
T6	1973	The UK joined the European Economic Community (EEC).
